

Student and Faculty Furniture Replacement

(Submission deadline is 12 p.m. CDT on July 14, 2021)

Purpose

The purpose of this request for proposal (RFP) is to invite prospective vendors to submit a proposal for replacing furniture found throughout the Colby Community College (CCC) campus. Currently, there is a substantial amount of non-matching all-in-one desks and chairs, various length stand-alone tables, and non-matching stand-alone and lab-style chairs. In addition to student furniture being replaced, CCC will be replacing each faculty office with a new faculty desk and office chair. The purpose of this RFP is to replace this furniture with antimicrobial furniture for efficient cleaning, and to provide a consistent feel across campus.

Overview:

In response to the Coronavirus pandemic, physical distancing and easy cleaning, disinfecting, and sanitizing has been critical for providing a safe environment for students on the CCC campus. Many classrooms on the CCC campus currently utilize a variety of different-sized tables and a wide variety of individual student desks. In order to provide a consistent feel across campus, accommodate physical distancing requirements, allow for easy cleaning, and maximize student capacity, CCC is replacing a vast majority of the furniture used by students on a daily basis. CCC is looking to purchase a family of seating that will provide a consistent and professional feel throughout campus. The most critical aspect of this RFP is that EVERY new piece of furniture must be antimicrobial characteristics.

Project Timeline:

The following is a tentative schedule that will apply to this RFP but may change in accordance with the organization's needs or unforeseen circumstances. Changes will be communicated by email to all invited bidders.

Scope of Work:

The selected vendor will be responsible for delivering and assembling the following pieces as depicted in each building outlined below. For desks that are considered ADA compliant and accessible for a wide range of disabilities, please provide documentation of its certification.

What is CCC responsible for?

- CCC will provide a staging area where the furniture may be assembled on campus in each of the buildings the furniture will be installed.
- CCC will be responsible for disposing of the current furniture.
- CCC will be responsible for appropriately spacing the furniture according to CDC guidelines.

What is the vendor responsible for?

- The vendor is responsible for verifying counts of furniture.
- The vendor is responsible for providing written manufacturer warranty information and product specification sheets from the manufacturer for products specified.
- The vendor should provide a description of how its furniture selection will benefit CCC's goal of a campus with a matched blending of furniture types.
- The vendor is responsible for providing a realistic documented timeline that encompasses at a minimum the following areas: ordering, receiving, verifying, delivery, and installation. For consistency purposes, CCC is requesting that vendors provide a Gantt chart or something similar to it.
- The vendor will coordinate and finalize finish selections upon the award of the contract.
- The vendor will only offer pieces of furniture that have hard and soft floor surface options in both glides and casters. The vendor must document/note soft caster and soft glide upcharges on the product specification sheet.
- The vendor is responsible for delivering the furniture to the CCC campus.
- The vendor is responsible for building and installing the pieces of furniture per manufacturer guidelines.
- The vendor must place the furniture in the appropriate classroom, and the final product must be structurally sound and delivered free of any blemish.
- The vendor is responsible for disposing of all trash and packaging associated with the delivered furniture.

RFP Revisions Summary – published June 16, 2021

The following revisions to the RFP have been made in response to vendor feedback:

- The weight capacity has been changed per chair.
- The type of flooring the furniture will be on has been added by each room number/name below. Please make the recommendation for the casters or glides accordingly. C = 28 oz Shaw carpet squares, and VCT = Vinyl Composition Tile
- Antimicrobial furniture may include poly/plastic shells which prevent germ growth and are easily cleaned. CCC prefers metal frames and not wood. The use of any fabrics is to be vinyl/synthetic options with a minimum of 100,000 double rubs or greater. For any laminate surfaces, they must be High-Pressure Laminate (HPL) and should not be Thermofused Laminate (TFL).
- Office Desks These desks are for faculty offices and do not need to be mobile. The desk should have a left and right pedestal file on the underside of the single desk.
- Delivery and installation should be a separate line item in the quote.
- CCC does not currently utilize buying contracts. However, CCC will make every effort to join a buying contract to realize cost savings. If a vendor uses a buying contract as part of the quote, please clearly disclose that in the proposal.
- If carton quantities do not match exactly what is requested, CCC will accept an additional or shortage of 1-2 items if cost savings are documented.
- General Student Chairs preference will be given to chairs that are stackable and handle the greatest weight capacity. Also, if the chairs have an option for arms, please disclose the cost of these as an "option." We do not have a minimum stack quantity.
- The backless rolling lab stools are used for both health care (Physical Therapist Assistant) and some science labs.
- If a virtual tour or pictures of the current furniture is desired, please contact Justin Villmer, and he will send them out.
- The date of completion CCC understands that there are shipping delays and have thus pushed the completion date back. Please document ways that you would recommend to minimize interruptions to students, and also a certification that you can be flexible in your time of day for work.

Requirements

The vendor is responsible for ensuring all materials and finishes are delivered and assembled in brand new condition, free of any blemish. The bid should reflect the cost of delivery and installation. All applicable workman's compensation, liability, and builders risk insurance needs are required to be provided by the vendor. This documentation should be submitted at the time of the award.

A warranty on the furniture is required. Please provide the details of the warranty. Preference will be given to products with longer warranties.

Exclusions

Any project exclusions or any portion of the proposal that cannot be provided must be disclosed in an area labeled *exclusions*. CCC will accept complete bid offering only to allow the project to have better coordination with faculty and staff of delivery and installation.

Communication

Verbal communication shall not be effective unless formally confirmed in writing by a specified procurement official in charge of managing this RFP process. In no case shall verbal communication govern over written communication.

Vendors' Inquiries. Applicable terms and conditions herein shall govern communications and inquiries between Colby Community College and vendors as they relate to this RFP. Proposal Submission

All sealed bids must be finalized and submitted by 12:00 p.m. on July 14, 2021, to Thomas Hall (CCC's Main Campus), attention: Justin Villmer. Vendors are required to prepare and submit, at their own cost, one signed original proposal. Submission must include the vendor's complete response, including all attachments, product services, and specifications where applicable. Electronic submission must be in PDF or Microsoft Word format.

Selection and Notification

The Board meeting will be held on Monday, July 26, 2021, to select a vendor. The selected vendor will be notified after approval has been received from the Board of Trustees.

Statement of Disclosure

The board reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to accept that bid which appears to be in the best interest of the college, to waive any informalities in any part of any bid, and to reject any or all bids received after the date and time specified. Any bid may be withdrawn before the scheduled time for the opening of bids. The bidder to whom the award is made may be required to enter into a written contract with the college and provide a performance or public works bond as required by law or the Board of Trustees (where applicable).
