

HEERF 2 Funds- Financial Aid Grant Report – as of June 30, 2021

The Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSA Act) provides funds to Colby Community College for emergency financial aid grants to students for costs of attendance expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to the coronavirus pandemic.

Colby Community College received \$234,724 (the same amount awarded for the CARES Act) to be provided directly to students to help cover costs accrued as a result of the pandemic. This is in compliance with the Department of Education’s Certification and Agreement for Higher Education Emergency Relief Funding and intends to use no less than 50 percent of the funds received under § 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

Students have the option of authorizing Colby Community College to apply any awarded funds directly to their bill or have the money refunded directly to them. Colby Community College does not automatically apply any funds to an account without authorization from the student

As of June 30, 2021, Colby Community College has awarded \$195,940 for emergency financial aid grants for students. The funds awarded are as follows:
