F-1 Student Sponsor Financial Affidavit

Immigration law requires a student requesting an F-1 student visa show that they have sufficient financial support to pay for their entire program of study. A financial sponsor declares to the US government that have at least the first year of funding available and set aside for the student's education, and they will continue to pay the fees for the duration of the program.

POLICY: Colby Community College is unable to offer financial aid for international students. It is the policy of CCC that all international students be able to finance their own education for each academic year.

Average annual cost of study: \$15,000 (U.S. Dollars)

This estimate is for nine months of study (Fall and Spring semester). This includes tuition, fees, room and board, books, optional activity fees, and personal expenses. The estimate does not include transportation to and from the United States, travel within this country, expenses during the summer months, or personal spending.
